Gen 11 Tower of Babel; Shem's Descendants to Abraham

- 27-30 The generations of Terah, the father of Abram.
31-32 Terah, with Abram and Lot, move from Ur to Haran

Gen 12 God Calls on Abram

- 1-3 God calls Abram out of his land, make of the a great nation, and bless them that bless thee & curse him that curseth thee.
4-5 He departs with Lot from Haran, and comes to Canaan.
6-6 He journeys through Canaan,
7-9 which is promised to his seed in a vision; Two altars are built
10-10 He is driven by famine into Egypt.
11-13 Fear makes him feign his wife to be his sister.
14-17 Pharaoh, having taken her from him, is compelled to restore her. Abram is well compensated. Hagar?
18-20 Pharaoh reproves Abram, whom he dismisses (a micro Exodus).

Gen 13 Abram and Lot Part Ways; Abram Promised Many Descendants

- 1-5 Abram and Lot return with great riches out of Egypt. 3rd altar built.
6-7 Strife arises between Abram's herdsmen and those of Lot.
8-9 Abram allows Lot to choose his part of the country,
10-13 and Lot goes toward Sodom.
14-17 God renews his promise of land to Abram. His seed numbered "like the dust of the earth",
18-18 He moves to Hebron, and there builds the 4th altar.

Gen 14 Abram Rescues Lot and Receives a Blessing from Melchizedek

- 1-11 The battle of four kings against the king of Sodom and his allies.
12-13 Lot is taken prisoner.
14-16 Abram rescues him.
17-20 Melchizedek blesses Abram, who gives him tithes.
21-24 Abram restores the rest of the spoil to the king of Sodom.

Gen 15 God's Covenant with Abram

- 1-3 God encourages Abram, who asks for an heir.
4-5 God promises him a son, and a multiplying of his seed.
6-6 Abram is justified by faith.
7-8 Canaan is promised again,
9-17 and confirmed by a sign, and a vision,
18-21 prophetic of the condition of his posterity till brought out of Egypt.

Gen 16 Sarai, Hagar, and Ishmael

- 1-3 Sarai, being barren, gives Hagar to Abram.
4-6 Hagar, being afflicted for despising her mistress, runs away.
7-9 An angel commands her to return and submit herself,
10-11 promises her a numerous posterity,
12-12 and shows their character and condition.
13-14 Hagar names the place, and returns to Sarai.
15-15 Ishmael is born.
16-16 The age of Abram.

Gen 17 Covenant of Circumcision with Abraham

- 1-4 God renews the covenant with Abram,
5-8 and changes his name to Abraham, in token of a greater blessing.
9-14 Circumcision is instituted.
15-16 Sarai's name is changed to Sarah, and she is blessed.
17-22 Isaac is promised, and the time of his birth fixed.
23-27 Abraham and Ishmael are circumcised.

Gen 18 God Promises the birth of Isaac; Abram Pleads for Sodom

- 1-8 The Lord appears to Abraham, who entertains angels.
9-15 Sarah is reproved for laughing at the promise of a son.
16-22 The destruction of Sodom is revealed to Abraham.
23-33 Abraham makes intercession for its inhabitants.

Gen 19 The Destruction of Sodom; Lot's daughters give birth

- 1-3 Lot entertains two angels.
- 4-11 The vicious Sodomites are smitten with blindness.
- 12-14 Lot is warned, and in vain warns his sons-in-law.
- 15-23 He is directed to flee to the mountains, but obtains leave to go into Zoar.
- 24-25 Sodom and Gomorrah are destroyed.
- 26-28 Lot's wife looks back and becomes a pillar of salt.
- 29-30 Lot dwells in a cave.
- 31-38 The incestuous origin of Moab and Ammon.

Gen 20 Abraham, Sarah and Abimelech

- 1-1 Abraham sojourns at Gerar.
- 2-2 Denies his wife, who is taken by Abimelech.
- 3-8 Abimelech is reproved for her in a dream.
- 9-13 He rebukes Abraham.
- 14-15 Restores Sarah;
- 16-16 and reproves her.
- 17-18 Abimelech and his family are healed at Abraham's prayer.

Gen 21 Isaac Born; Hagar and Ishmael Sent Away; Treaty at Beersheba

- 1-5 Isaac is born, and circumcised.
- 6-7 Sarah's joy.
- 8-8 Isaac is weaned.
- 9-14 Hagar and Ishmael sent away.
- 15-16 Hagar in distress.
- 17-22 The angel relieves and comforts her.
- 23-34 Abimelech's covenant with Abraham at Beersheba.

Gen 22 The Offering of Isaac; Nahor's sons

- 1-2 Abraham is tested with the command to offer Isaac.
- 3-10 He gives proof of his faith and obedience.
- 11-12 The angel prevents him.
- 13-13 Isaac is exchanged for a ram.
- 14-14 The place is called Jehovah-jireh.
- 15-19 Abraham is again blessed.
- 20-24 The generations of Nahor unto Rebekah.

Gen 23 Death and Burial of Sarah

- 1-2 The age and death of Sarah.
- 3-18 The purchase of the field and cave of Machpelah;
- 19-20 where Sarah is buried.

Gen 24 Isaac and Rebekah

- 1-9 Abraham swears his servant.
- 10-11 The servant's journey.
- 12-13 His prayer.
- 14-14 His sign.
- 15-17 Rebekah meets him;
- 18-21 fulfils his sign;
- 22-22 receives jewels;
- 23-24 shows her kindred;
- 25-25 and invites him home.
- 26-28 The servant blesses God.
- 29-33 Laban entertains him.
- 34-49 The servant shows his message.
- 50-57 Laban and Bethuel approve it.
- 58-61 Rebekah consents to go, and departs.
- 62-67 Isaac meets and marries her.

Gen 25 Abraham's Death; Ishmael, Jacob and Esau

- 1-4 The sons of Abraham by Keturah.
- 5-6 The division of his goods.
- 7-10 His age, death, and burial.
- 11-11 God blesses Isaac.
- 12-16 The generations of Ishmael.
- 17-18 His age and death.
- 19-21 Isaac prays for Rebekah, being barren.
- 22-23 The children strive in her womb.
- 24-26 The birth of Esau and Jacob.
- 27-28 Their different characters and pursuits.
- 29-34 Esau sells his birthright.
