Mat 4:1-4

¹ Then was Jesus led up of the Spirit into the wilderness ^C to be tempted of the devil. ² And when he had fasted forty days ⁴⁰ and forty nights ⁴⁰, he was afterward an hungred. ³ And when the tempter came to him, he said, If thou be the Son of God, command that these stones be made bread. ⁴ But he answered and said, **It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God.**

^B **Act 15:19-21** ¹⁹ Wherefore my sentence is, that we trouble not them, which from among the Gentiles are turned to God: ²⁰ But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and *from* fornication, and *from* things strangled, and *from* blood. ²¹ For Moses of old time hath in every city them that preach him, being read in the synagogues every sabbath day.

Deu 8:1-3 – these verses reference back to Exo 16 etc.

¹ All the commandments which I command thee this day shall ye observe to do, that ye may live, and multiply, and go in and possess the land which YHVH swore unto your fathers. ² And thou shalt remember all the way which YHVH thy God led thee these forty years ^[Exo 16:35] in the wilderness, to humble thee, *and* to prove (אִתְּךָ) *nis-Sa-hu*) ^{D [Exo 16:4, 20]} thee, to know what *was* in thine heart, whether thou wouldest keep his commandments, or no. ³ And he humbled thee, and suffered thee to hunger, and fed thee with manna, which thou knewest not, neither did thy fathers know; that he might make thee know that man doth not live by bread only, but by every *word* that proceedeth out of the mouth of YHVH doth man live.
