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Deu 12 - Laws of the Sanctuary

When YHVH *eloheicha* shall enlarge thy border, as he hath promised thee, and thou shalt say, I will eat flesh, because thy soul longeth to eat flesh; thou mayest eat flesh, whatsoever thy soul lusteth after. ²¹ If the place which YHVH *eloheicha* hath chosen to put his name there be too far from thee, then thou shalt kill of thy herd and of thy flock, which YHVH hath given thee, as I have commanded thee, and thou shalt eat in thy gates whatsoever thy soul lusteth after. ²² Even as the roebuck and the hart is eaten, so thou shalt eat them: the unclean and the clean shall eat of them alike. ²³ Only be sure that thou eat not the blood and the flesh. ²⁴ Thou shalt not eat it; thou shalt pour it upon the earth as water. ²⁵ Thou shalt not eat it; that it may go well with thee, and with thy children after thee, when thou shalt do that which is right in the sight of YHVH.

Idolatry is not to be enquired after

When YHVH *eloheicha* shall cut off אָת ' yach Rit' אָת' the nations from before thee, whither thou goest to possess them, and thou succeedest them, and dwellest in their land; 30 Take heed to thyself that thou be not snared by following them, after that they be destroyed from before thee; and that thou inquire not after their gods, saying, How did these nations serve their gods? even so will I do likewise. 31 Thou shalt not do so unto YHVH *eloheicha*: for every abomination אוער דעבר to 'a 'Vat H8441 to YHVH, which he hateth, have they done unto their gods; for even their sons and their daughters they have burnt in the fire to their gods. B 32 [13:1] What thing soever I command you, observe to do it: thou shalt not add thereto, nor diminish from it.

Deu 13 – Put to Death the False Prophets

Enticers to idolatry

¹[13:2] If there arise among you a prophet, or a dreamer of dreams, and giveth thee a sign or a wonder, ²[13:3] And the sign or the wonder come to pass, whereof he spake unto thee, saying, Let us go after other gods, which thou hast not known, and let us serve them; ³[13:4] Thou shalt not hearken unto the words of that prophet, or that dreamer of dreams: for YHVH your God proveth you, to know whether ye love YHVH your God with all your heart and with all your soul. ⁴[13:5] Ye shall walk after YHVH your God, and fear him, and keep his commandments, and obey his voice, and ye shall serve him, and cleave unto him. ⁵[13:6] And that prophet, or that dreamer of dreams, shall be put to death; because he hath spoken to turn you away from YHVH your God, which brought you out of the land of Egypt, and redeemed you out of the house of bondage, to thrust thee out of the way which YHVH *eloheicha* commanded thee to walk in. So shalt thou put the evil away from the midst of thee.

⁶[13:7] If thy brother, the son of thy mother, or thy son, or thy daughter, or the wife of thy bosom, or thy friend, which is as thine own soul, entice thee secretly, saying, Let us go and serve other gods, which thou hast not known, thou, nor thy fathers; ⁷[13:8] Namely, of the gods of the people which are round about you, nigh unto thee, or far off from thee, from the one end of the earth even unto the other end of the earth; ⁸[13:9] Thou shalt not consent unto him, nor hearken unto him; neither shall thine eye pity him, neither shalt thou spare, neither shalt thou conceal him:

are to be stoned to death

⁹[13:10] But thou shalt surely kill him; thine hand shall be first upon him to put him to death, and afterwards the hand of all the people. ¹⁰[13:11] And thou shalt stone him with stones, that he die; because he hath sought to thrust thee away from YHVH *eloheicha*, which brought thee out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage. ¹¹[13:12] And all Israel shall hear, and fear, and shall do no more any such wickedness as this is among you.

Idolatrous cities are not to be spared

¹²[13:13] If thou shalt hear say in one of thy cities, which YHVH *eloheicha* hath given thee to dwell there, saying, ¹³[13:14] Certain men, the children of Belial, are gone out from among you, and have withdrawn the inhabitants of their city, saying, Let us go and serve other gods, which ye have not known; ¹⁴[13:15] Then shalt thou inquire, and make search, and ask diligently; and, behold, if it be truth, and the thing certain, that such abomination is wrought among you; ¹⁵[13:16] Thou shalt surely smite the inhabitants of that city with the edge of the sword, destroying it utterly, and all that is therein, and the cattle thereof, with the edge of the sword. ¹⁶[13:17] And thou shalt gather all the spoil of it into the midst of the street thereof, and shalt burn with fire the city, and all the spoil thereof every whit, for YHVH *eloheicha*: and it shall be an heap for ever; it shall not be built again. ¹⁷[13:18] And there shall cleave nought of the cursed thing to thine hand: that YHVH may turn from the fierceness of his anger, and show thee mercy, and have compassion upon thee, and multiply thee, as he hath sworn unto thy fathers; ¹⁸[13:19] When thou shalt hearken to the voice of YHVH *eloheicha*, to keep all his commandments which I command thee this day, to do that which is right in the eyes of YHVH *eloheicha*.

Deu 14 - Eating Only Clean Animals; Tithes

God's children are not to disfigure themselves in mourning

¹ Ye are the children of YHVH your God: ye shall not cut yourselves, nor make any baldness between your eyes for the dead. ² For thou art an holy people unto YHVH *eloheicha*, and YHVH hath chosen thee to be a peculiar people unto himself, above all the nations that are upon the earth.

What may and may not be eaten

of animals

⁴ These are the beasts which ye shall eat: the ox, the sheep, and the goat, ⁵ The hart, and the roebuck, and the fallow deer, and the wild goat, and the pygarg, and the wild ox, and the chamois. ⁶ And every beast that parteth the hoof, and cleaveth the cleft into two claws, and cheweth the cud among the beasts, that ye shall eat. ⁷ Nevertheless these ye shall not eat of them that chew the cud, or of them that divide the cloven hoof; as the camel, and the hare, and the coney: for they chew the cud, but divide not the hoof; therefore they are unclean unto you. ⁸ And the swine, because it divideth the hoof, yet cheweth not the cud, it is unclean unto you: ye shall not eat of their flesh, nor touch their dead carcass.

of fishes

⁹ These ye shall eat of all that are in the waters: all that have fins and scales shall ye eat: ¹⁰ And whatsoever hath not fins and scales ye may not eat; it is unclean unto you.

of fowls

¹¹ Of all clean birds ye shall eat. ¹² But these are they of which ye shall not eat: the eagle, and the ossifrage, and the ospray, ¹³ And the glede, and the kite, and the vulture after his kind, ¹⁴ And every raven after his kind, ¹⁵ And the owl, and the night hawk, and the cuckoo, and the hawk after his kind, ¹⁶ The little owl, and the great owl, and the swan, ¹⁷ And the pelican, and the gier eagle, and the cormorant, ¹⁸ And the stork, and the heron after her kind, and the lapwing, and the bat. ¹⁹ And every creeping thing that flieth is unclean unto you: they shall not be eaten. ²⁰ But of all clean fowls ye may eat.

That which dies of itself may not be eaten

Ye shall not eat of anything that dieth of itself: thou shalt give it unto the stranger that is in thy gates, that he may eat it; or thou mayest sell it unto an alien: for thou art an holy people unto YHVH *eloheicha*. Thou shalt not seethe a kid in his mother's milk.

Tithes of Divine Service

Thou shalt truly tithe all the increase of thy seed, that the field bringeth forth year by year.

Tithes and firstborns to be eaten before YHVH

And thou shalt eat before YHVH *eloheicha*, in the place which he shall choose to place his name there, the tithe of thy corn, of thy wine, and of thine oil, and the firstlings of thy herds and of thy flocks; that thou mayest learn to fear YHVH *eloheicha* always. And if the way be too long for thee, so that thou art not able to carry it; or if the place be too far from thee, which YHVH *eloheicha* shall choose to set his name there, when YHVH *eloheicha* hath blessed thee: Then shalt thou turn it into money, and bind up the money in thine hand, and shalt go unto the place which YHVH *eloheicha* shall choose: And thou shalt bestow that money for whatsoever thy soul lusteth after, for oxen, or for sheep, or for wine, or for strong drink, or for whatsoever thy soul desireth: and thou shalt eat there before YHVH *eloheicha*, and thou shalt rejoice, thou, and thine

household, ²⁷ And the Levite that is within thy gates; thou shalt not forsake him; for he hath no part nor inheritance with thee.

The third year's tithe of alms and charity

At the end of three years thou shalt bring forth all the tithe of thine increase the same year, and shalt lay it up within thy gates: ²⁹ And the Levite, (because he hath no part nor inheritance with thee,) and the stranger, and the fatherless, and the widow, which are within thy gates, shall come, and shall eat and be satisfied; that YHVH *eloheicha* may bless thee in all the work of thine hand which thou doest.

Deu 15 - The Seventh Year: Debts to be Cancelled, Servants Freed

The seventh year a year of release for the poor

¹ At the end of every seven years thou shalt make a release. ² And this is the manner of the release: Every creditor that lendeth ought unto his neighbor shall release it; he shall not exact it of his neighbor, or of his brother; because it is called YHVH's release. ³ Of a foreigner thou mayest exact it again: but that which is thine with thy brother thine hand shall release; ⁴ Save when there shall be no poor among you; for YHVH shall greatly bless thee in the land which YHVH *eloheicha* giveth thee for an inheritance to possess it: ⁵ Only if thou carefully hearken unto the voice of YHVH *eloheicha*, to observe to do all these commandments which I command thee this day. ⁶ For YHVH *eloheicha* blesseth thee, as he promised thee: and thou shalt lend unto many nations, but thou shalt not borrow; and thou shalt reign over many nations, but they shall not reign over thee.

Deu 18:15-22 — The prophet that Israel must listen to; and a warning of false prophets

Compare the Deu 13:1-11 verses with the famous verses found in Deu chapter 18 (see the next two paragraphs) and ask yourself a question regarding the claim from antinomian Christianity regarding the Messiah. Does the testimony of Yeshua from antinomian Christianity better fit Deu 18:15-19 or is Deu 18:20-22 a better fit?

Deu 18:15-19 - YHHV will rise up a prophet like Moses

Deu 18:20-22 – The false prophet who speaks in my name shall die.

But the prophet, which shall presume to speak a word in my name, The which I have not commanded him to speak, or that shall speak in the name of other gods, even that prophet shall die. 613-310 21 And if thou say in thine heart, How shall we knowthe word which YHVH hath not spoken? 22 When a prophet speaketh in the name of YHVH, if the thing follow not, nor come to pass, that is the thing which YHVH hath not spoken, but the prophet hath spoken it presumptuously: thou shalt not be afraid of him. 613-311
