Introduction

This article list verses (I count 26) that convey the idea of God and his people. In addition these verses will show the God is with his people i.e. Emmanuel ^a. The intent is to show that it is Israel who has a covenant with YHVH and not some made up thing called the "church" which is theological construct of Antinomian Christianity. Torah

Gen 17:7-8 ⁷ And I will establish my covenant between me and thee and <u>thy seed</u> ^b after thee in their generations for an everlasting covenant, to be a God unto thee, and to thy seed after thee. ⁸ And I will give unto thee, and to thy seed after thee, the land wherein thou art a stranger, all the land of Canaan, for an everlasting possession; and <u>I</u> will be their God.

Exo 6:7 And I will <u>take you to me for a people</u>, and I will be to <u>you a God</u>: and ye shall know that I *am* YHVH <u>your God</u>, which bringeth you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians.

Exo 19:5-6 ⁵ Now therefore, if ye will obey my voice indeed, and keep my covenant, then <u>ye shall be a peculiar treasure unto me</u> above all people: ^c for all the earth *is* mine: ⁶ And ye shall be unto me a kingdom of priests, and an holy nation. These *are* the words which thou shalt speak unto the children of Israel.

Exo 29:45-46 ⁴⁵ And I will dwell among the children of Israel, and will be their God. ⁴⁶ And they shall know that I *am* YHVH their God, that brought them forth out of the land of Egypt, that I may dwell among them: I *am* YHVH their God.

Lev 26:11-12 ¹¹ And I will set my tabernacle among you: and my soul shall not abhor you. ¹² And I will walk among you, and will be your God, and ye shall be my people.
