### Num 19:13

Whosoever toucheth the dead body of any man that is dead, and purifieth not himself, defileth the tabernacle of YHVH; and that soul shall be cut off from Israel: because the water of separation was not sprinkled upon him, he shall be unclean; his uncleanness is yet upon him.

### Num 31:23-24

<sup>23</sup> Every thing that may abide the fire, ye shall make *it* go through the fire, and it shall be clean: nevertheless it shall be purified with the water of separation: and all that abideth not the fire ye shall make go through the water. <sup>24</sup> And ye shall wash your clothes on the seventh day, and ye shall be clean, and afterward ye shall come into the camp.

#### Lev 15:20-21

<sup>20</sup> And every thing that she lieth upon in her separation shall be unclean: every thing also that she sitteth upon shall be unclean. <sup>21</sup> And whosoever toucheth her bed shall wash his clothes, and bathe *himself* in water, and be unclean until the even.

### Zec 13:1

<sup>1</sup> In that day there shall be a fountain opened to the house of David and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem for sin and for uncleanness.

### Heb 9:13-14

<sup>13</sup> For if the blood of bulls and of goats, and <u>the ashes of an heifer</u> sprinkling the unclean, sanctifieth to the purifying of the flesh: <sup>14</sup> How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?
