To **follow after** (Luk 17:23). To follow or press hard after, to **pursue** with earnestness and diligence in order **to obtain**, to go after with the desire of obtaining (Rom 9:30-31; Rom 12:13; Rom 14:19; 1Co 14:1; Phi 3:12, Phi 3:14; 1Th 5:15; 1Ti 6:11; 2Ti 2:22; Heb 12:14; 1Pe 3:11).
