Feminine of [G2190](#); *hostility*; by implication a reason for *opposition*: - enmity, hatred.

From a primary word ἐχθῶ echthō (to hate); *hateful* (passively *odious*, or actively *hostile*); usually as a noun, an *adversary* (especially *Satan*): - enemy, foe.
