ktísis; gen. *ktíseōs*, fem. noun from *ktízoō* ([G2936](#)), to create, form or found. Something founded, i.e., of a city, colonization of a habitable place. Creation, in a pass. sense, what has been created, the sum total of what has been created ([Mar 10:6](#); [Mar 13:19](#); [Rom 1:20](#); [Rom 8:19-22](#); [Heb 9:11](#); [1Pe 2:13](#); [2Pe 3:4](#); [Rev 3:14](#)). Denotes a particular created thing ([Rom 1:25](#); [Rom 8:39](#); [Col 1:15](#); [Heb 4:13](#)). Refers specifically to mankind as God's creation ([Mar 16:15](#); [Col 1:23](#) [cf. *kainē* {[G2537](#)}, qualitatively new, with *ktísis*, creation or creature {[2Co 5:17](#); [Gal 6:15](#)}]).

Syn.: *oikodomē* ([G3619](#)), a building in the process of being erected; *endómēsis* ([G1739](#)), a thing built, structure; *égersis* ([G1454](#)), a raising up.

Ant.: *katháiresis* (g2506), demolition.
