Denotes a particular created thing (Rom 1:25; Rom 8:39; Col 1:15; Heb 4:13). Refers specifically to mankind as God's creation (Mar 16:15; Col 1:23 [cf. kainé {G2537}, qualitatively new, with ktísis, creation or creature {2Co 5:17; Gal 6:15}]).
