Strong's: From a compound of the base of [G3674](#) (*homo* same) and [G3056](#) (*logos* word, something said,); to assent, that is, *covenant, acknowledge*: - con- (pro-) fess, confession is made, give thanks, promise.

Thayer Definition:

- 1) to say the same thing as another, i.e. to agree with, assent
- 2) to concede
 - 2a) not to refuse, to promise
 - 2b) not to deny
 - 2b1) to confess
 - 2b2) declare
 - 2b3) to confess, i.e. to admit or declare one's self guilty of what one is accused of
- 3) to profess
 - 3a) to declare openly, speak out freely
 - 3b) to profess one's self the worshipper of one
- 4) to praise, celebrate
