proskomma; gen. *proskómmatos*, neut. noun from *proskóptō* (G4350), to stumble. A stumbling. In the NT used figuratively, a stone of stumbling, spoken of Christ as the occasion to fall and the perdition of those who reject Him (Rom 9:32-33; 1Pe 2:8 [cf. Isa 8:14]). See *líthos* (G3037), stone, where it is used with *proskomma* as a stumblingblock. Figuratively, a cause of falling, an occasion of sinning (Rom 14:13, Rom 14:20; 1Co 8:9; Sept.: Exo 23:33; Exo 34:12).

Syn.: *skándalon* (G4625), an obstacle, that which causes someone to stumble.

Ant.: *boētheia* (G996), help; *epikouría* (G1947), assistance.
