### Word Study G4735 stephanos Crown, Jam 1:12

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### Introduction

A crown is the symbol worn by royalty. Israel is a Kingdom of priests who adorns the crown of life.

**Jam 1:1**. I chose to focus this word study on a verse found in James. I love how in this book, in the first verse, James introduces himself by 1<sup>st</sup> stating <u>his legal status</u> "a servant of God and of Y'shua HaMeshiach", 2<sup>nd</sup> <u>identifies his audience</u> "the twelve tribes" and 3<sup>rd</sup> <u>the legal status</u> and condition of those twelve tribes ("which are scattered abroad"). His target audience is <u>not</u> the Gentiles, but rather the twelve tribes who have been scattered amongst the gentiles/nations (*goyim*).

# Jam 1:12 – endureth temptation after being tried receive the crown (*stephanos*) of life.

Blessed *is* the man that endureth temptation: for when he is tried,<sup>a</sup> he shall receive the **crown** (*stephanos* <sup>G4735</sup>) of life, which the Lord hath promised to them that love him.
