²³ Therefore is the kingdom of heaven likened unto a certain king, which would take *sunario*^{G4868} account *logos*^{G3056} ^A of his servants. ²⁴ And when he had begun to reckon *sunario*^{G4868}, one was brought unto him, which owed him ten thousand talents.

Mat 25:19 – parable of the talents

After a long time the lord of those servants cometh, and reckoneth *sunario*^{G4868} *logos*^{G3056} with them.

G4868 *sunairo*^{KJC:3} recon(eth)2, take 1; LXX H5800

Strong's From [G4862](#) and [G142](#); to *make up together*, that is, (figuratively) to *compute* (an account): - reckon, take.

KJC 3: **reckon 1** [Mat 18:24](#), **reckoneth 1**, [Mat 25:19](#) **take 1**, [Mat 18:23](#)

Mat 18:23, 24 is part of the Parable of the Unforgiving Slave.
