Gen 21:8 | Isaac was weaned

⁸ And the child grew, and was **weaned**:^A and Abraham made a great feast the *same* day that Isaac was weaned.

Gen 50:15-17 | Joseph's brothers think he will return the evil they did to him

¹⁵ And when Joseph's brethren saw that their father was dead, they said, Joseph will peradventure hate us, and will certainly requite *shuv shuv* us all the evil which we **did** unto him. ¹⁶ And they sent a messenger unto Joseph, saying, Thy father did command before he died, saying, ¹⁷ So shall ye say unto Joseph, Forgive, I pray thee now, the trespass of thy brethren, and their sin; for they **did** unto thee evil: and now, we pray thee, forgive the trespass of the servants of the God of thy father. ⁶ Do ye thus **requite** the LORD, O foolish people and unwise? *is* not he thy father *that* hath bought thee? hath

גַּמַּל

A primitive root; to *treat* a person (well or ill), that is, *benefit* or *requite*; by implication (of *toil*) to *ripen*, that is, (specifically) to *wean*: - bestow on, deal bountifully, do (good), recompense, requite, reward, ripen, + serve, wean, yield.
