From [H3789](#); something *written*, that is, a *writing*, *record* or *book*: - **register**, scripture, writing.

¹ And it came to pass in those days, that there went out a decree^{G1378 dogma} from Caesar Augustus, that all the world should be taxed^{G583 apographo}. ² (And this taxing^{G582 apographe} was first made when Cyrenius was governor of Syria.) ³ And all went to be taxed,^{G583}, every one into his own city. ⁴ And Joseph also went up from Galilee, out of the city of Nazareth, into Judaea, unto the city of David, which is called Bethlehem; (because he was of the house and lineage of David:) ⁵ To be taxed^{G583} with Mary his espoused wife, being great with child. ⁶ And so it was, that, while they were there, the days were accomplished that she should be delivered.

all. Figure of speech *Synecdoche* (of the whole) for a part of the whole; i.e. the Roman Empire.

world. Greek. *oikoumene*. See [App-129](#). Compare [Act 11:28](#).

taxed = **enrolled, or registered**.

this taxing was first made = this was the first **registration** to be made. A second is recorded in [Act 5:37](#).⁷

Cyrenius. Greek for the Latin *Quirinus*. His full name was Publius Sulpicius Quirinus.
