¹ And it came to pass in those days, that there went out a decree^{G1378 dogma} from Caesar Augustus, that all the world should be taxed ^{G583 apographo}. ² (And this taxing^{G582 apographe} was first made when Cyrenius was governor of Syria.) ³ And all went to be taxed,^{G583}, every one into his own city. ⁴ And Joseph also went up from Galilee, out of the city of Nazareth, into Judaea, unto the city of David, which is called Bethlehem; (because he was of the house and lineage of David:) ⁵ To be taxed^{G583} with Mary his espoused wife, being great with child. ⁶ And so it was, that, while they were there, the days were accomplished that she should be delivered.

Luke 2:1

it came to pass in those days. The seventh and last occurrence of this ominous phrase. See note on <u>Gen_14:1</u>. it came to pass. A Hebraism, frequent in Luke. Compare <u>Luk_1:8</u>. in. Greek. *en.* <u>App-104</u>. a decree = an edict, from. Greek. *para.* <u>App-104</u>. all. Figure of speech Synecdoche (of the whole) for a part of the whole; i.e. the Roman Empire. world. Greek. *oikoumene*. See <u>App-129</u>. Compare <u>Act_11:28</u>. taxed = enrolled, or registered.

Luke 2:2

this taxing was first made = this was the first registration to be made. A second is recorded in <u>Act_5:37</u>.⁷ Cyrenius. Greek for the Latin *Quirinus*. *His* full name was Publius Sulpicius Quirinus.
