^A the first place the word *DeRaSh* ^{H1875} (require) is found and it's used three times. See "PaRDeS-Table-Cheat-Sheet" article #[297](#).

^B According to the Stone's Chumash, the second (the goat שְׁעִיר *se-'Ir*) and third word of this verse (diligently דָּרַשׁ *da-Rosh*) is **exactly the half-way point of the Torah**. This teaches us that the entire Torah revolves around constant inquiry and one must never stop studying and seeking an ever deeper and broader understanding of the Torah (Degel Machaneh Ephraim).

JKM: it is interesting that the word is *darosh*, which is the same word (or at least the root) of PaRDeS. It's also interesting that this word is repeated twice (therefore the third word).

A primitive root; properly to *tread* or *frequent*; usually to *follow* (for pursuit or search); by implication to *seek* or *ask*; specifically to *worship*: - ask, X at all, care for, X diligently, inquire, make inquisition, [necro-] mancer, question, require, search, seek [for, out], X surely.
