

Word Study ^{H376} Ish v. ^{H120} Adam

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Num 23:19 God *is* not a man, אִישׁ ^{H376} that he should lie; neither the son of man, בֶּן־אָדָם ^{H120} that he should repent: hath he said, and shall he not do *it*? or hath he spoken, and shall he not make it good?

Job 35:8 Thy wickedness *may hurt* a man אִישׁ ^{H376} as thou *art*; and thy righteousness *may profit* the son of man. בֶּן־אָדָם ^{H120}

Psa 80:17 Let thy hand be upon the man אִישׁ ^{H376} of thy right hand, upon the son of man בֶּן־אָדָם ^{H120} whom thou madest strong for thyself.

Jer 49:18 As in the overthrow of Sodom and Gomorrah and the neighbour *cities* thereof, saith the LORD, no man אִישׁ ^{H376} shall abide there, neither shall a son of man בֶּן־אָדָם ^{H120} dwell in it.

Jer 49:33 And Hazer shall be a dwelling for dragons, *and* a desolation for ever: there shall no man אִישׁ ^{H376} abide there, nor *any* son of man בֶּן־אָדָם ^{H120} dwell in it.

Jer 50:40 As God overthrew ^ו Sodom and Gomorrah and the neighbour *cities* thereof, saith the LORD; *so* shall no man אִישׁ ^{H376} abide there, neither shall any son of man בֶּן־אָדָם ^{H120} dwell therein.

Jer 51:43 Her cities are a desolation, a dry land, and a wilderness, a land wherein no man אִישׁ ^{H376} dwelleth, neither doth *any* son of man בֶּן־אָדָם ^{H120} pass thereby.

Eze 8:12 Then said he unto me, Son of man, בֶּן־אָדָם ^{H120} hast thou seen what the ancients of the house of Israel do in the dark, every man אִישׁ ^{H376} in the chambers of his imagery? for they say, The LORD seeth us not; the LORD hath forsaken ^ו the earth.

Eze 11:2 Then said he unto me, Son of man, בֶּן־אָדָם ^{H120} these *are* the men אִישׁ ^{H376} that devise mischief, and give wicked counsel in this city:

Eze 11:15 Son of man, בֶּן־אָדָם ^{H120} thy brethren, *even* thy brethren, the men אִישׁ ^{H376} of thy kindred, and all the house of Israel wholly, *are* they unto whom the inhabitants of Jerusalem have said, Get you far from the LORD: unto us is this land given in possession.

Eze 14:3 Son of man, בֶּן־אָדָם ^{H120} these men אִישׁ ^{H376} have set up their idols in their heart, and put the stumblingblock of their iniquity before their face: should I be enquired of at all by them?

Eze 33:2 Son of man, בֶּן־אָדָם ^{H120} speak to the children of thy people, and say unto them, When I bring the sword upon a land, if the people of the land take a man אִישׁ ^{H376} of their coasts, and set him for their watchman:

Eze 33:30 Also, thou son of man, בֶּן־אָדָם ^{H120} the children of thy people still are talking against thee by the walls and in the doors of the houses, and speak one to another, every one אִישׁ ^{H376} to his brother, saying, Come, I pray you, and hear what is the word that cometh forth from the LORD.

Eze 40:4 And the man אִישׁ ^{H376} said unto me, Son of man, בֶּן־אָדָם ^{H120} behold with thine eyes, and hear with thine ears, and set thine heart upon all that I shall shew thee; for to the intent that I might shew *them* unto thee *art* thou brought hither: declare ^ו all that thou seest to the house of Israel.

Can the one, *ish*, relate to the heavenly realm/jurisdiction and the other, *adam*, related to the earthly realm/jurisdiction?
