⁹Now therefore, behold, the cry of the children of Israel יִשְׂרָאֵל is come unto me: and I have also seen the **oppression לְחֵצִי** wherewith the Egyptians **oppress** לֹחֲצִים lo·cha·Tzim them.

H3906 lachats KJC:7, oppression

lahas: A masculine noun referring to oppression, affliction. It refers to various kinds of oppression or distress: the oppression of Israel (Exo 3:9; Deu 26:7; 2Ki 13:4). The term "bread of oppression" (lahas) means, in context, a prisoner's ration, a small amount (1Ki 22:27). It indicates the oppression the psalmist suffered at the hands of his enemies (Psa 42:9 [10]; Psa 43:2). It is used of a period of affliction or oppression given by the Lord (Isa 30:20).
