Introduction

Interesting how the word *Mem Sheen Lamed mashal* ¹ is broken up into three Strong's numbers. <u>H4911</u> and <u>H4912</u> seem very similar (**proverb, parable**, etc.) but <u>H4910</u> is quite different (e.g. **rule, dominion, power, reign bare**).

Deu 15:6 – "thou shalt reign (mashal H4910) over many nations"

⁶ For YHVH thy Elohim blesseth thee, as he promised thee: and thou shalt lend unto many nations, but thou shalt not borrow; and **thou shalt reign over many nations**, but they shall not reign over thee.

A Thought

Could it be that those who possess this quality of being able to distinguish themselves as being sovereign from those who are the public²? Is it also reflective of those who have truly received and grasped what it means to have the "Ruach Hakodesh"?

More usage

H4912 is translated as proverb occurs 7 times at Balaam's Oracles: Num 23:7, 18, 24:3, 15, 20, 21 & 23. **Deu 28:37** KJV ³⁷ And thou shalt become an astonishment, a proverb H4912, and a byword, among all nations whither YHVH shall lead thee. ³

Apparently from <u>H4910</u> in some original sense of *superiority* in mental action; properly a pithy *maxim*, usually of a metaphorical nature; hence a *simile* (as an adage, poem, discourse): - byword, like, parable, proverb.
