### 1Sa 9:16 KJV

To morrow about this time I will send thee a man out of the land of Benjamin, and thou shalt anoint him to be captain *nagid* <sup>H5057</sup> over my people Israel, that he may save my people out of the hand of the Philistines: for I have looked upon my people, because their cry is come unto me.
