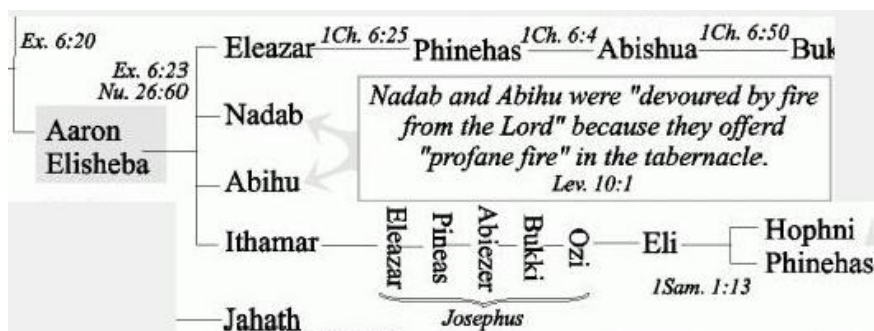

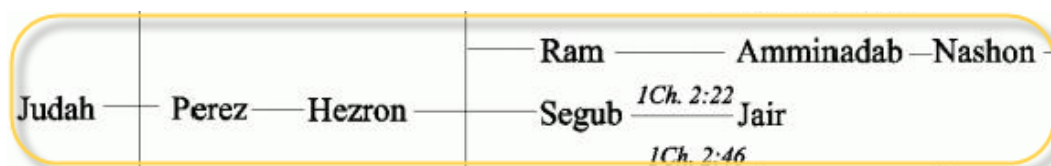
### Exo 6:23 – Aaron’s family

BDB Definition:

**Nahshon** = “enchanter”

1) son of Amminadab and prince of the Judah at the first numbering in the wilderness; 5th in descent from Judah in the genealogy of Christ

## H5992 *ammiynadab* “my kinsman is noble”

אֲמִינָדָב

### **BDB Definition:**

**Amminadab** = “my kinsman is noble”

- 1) son of Ram or Aram and father of Nahshon or Naasson and an ancestor of Jesus; father-in-law of Aaron
- 2) a Kohathite Levite and chief of the sons of Uzziel
- 3) a Levite, son of Kohath; also ‘Izhar’

**Part of Speech:** noun proper masculine
