נָטַשׁ

A primitive root; properly to *pound*, that is, *smite*; by implication (as if beating out, and thus expanding) to *disperse*; also, to *thrust off*, down, out or upon (including *reject*, *let alone*, *permit*, *remit*, etc.): - cast off, drawn, let fall, forsake, join [battle], leave (off), lie still, loose, spread (self) abroad, stretch out, suffer.
