A primitive root; to *guard*, in a good sense (to *protect*, *maintain*, *obey*, etc.) or a bad one (to *conceal*, etc.): - besieged, hidden thing, keep (-er, -ing), monument, observe, preserve (-r), subtil, watcher (-man).

nasar: A verb meaning to guard, to keep, to observe, to preserve, to hide. The word refers to people's maintaining things entrusted to them, especially to keeping the truths of God in both actions and mind (Psa_119:100, Psa_119:115). God's Word is to be kept with our whole hearts (Psa_119:69); our hearts, in turn, ought to be maintained in a right state (Pro_4:23). The word also refers to keeping speech under control (Psa_34:13 [14]; Psa_141:3); the maintenance of a tree (Pro_27:18); the work of God's character (Psa_40:11 [12]); its reflection in humans as preserving them (Psa_25:21; Pro_2:11). Sometimes the word refers directly to God's preservation and maintenance of His people (Pro_24:12; Isa_49:8). The passive participle form of the verb describes an adulteress' heart as guarded or kept secret (Pro_7:10). It also describes a city as guarded or besieged (Isa_1:8). The active participle is used to signify a watchman (2Ki_17:9; Jer_31:6).

From H5341 in the sense of *greenness* as a striking color; a *shoot*; figuratively, a *descendant:* - branch.

LXX: G438 anthos

WordStudy

A masculine noun referring to a branch. It indicates literally a shoot, a branch of a plant but is used figuratively of the Lord's servant, the Branch, who will rule in the messianic kingdom. He comes from the roots of the family of Jesse (<u>Isa_11:1</u>), the chosen royal line in Israel. It refers to Israel as a whole as God's branch in a restored state (<u>Isa_60:21</u>). It indicates a person as part of a family line (<u>Isa_14:9</u>); as a descendant in particular (<u>Dan_11:7</u>).
