Exo 15:18 YHVH shall $\mathbf{reign}^{H4427 \ malak}$ for \mathbf{ever}^{H5769} and \mathbf{ever}^{H5703} .

In the (in)famous verses of <u>1Sa_8:6-7</u>, it can be shown that YHVH was the first King of Israel by clear implication because when they say "...Give us a king H4428 *melek* to judge H8199 *shaphat* us." (1Sa 8:6 KJV), they are implying that YHVH **was** there King.

'ad: A noun meaning eternity. The word signifies God's dwelling place (<u>Isa_57:15</u>). It also refers to the continuance of a king on the throne (<u>Exo_15:18</u>; <u>1Ch_28:9</u>; <u>Psa_132:12</u>; <u>Pro_29:14</u>). The word can indicate continual joy (<u>Psa_61:8</u> [9]; <u>Isa_65:18</u>); or continual anger (<u>Mic_7:18</u>; <u>Amo_1:11</u>). The word's references to mountains that would be shattered (<u>Hab_3:6</u>); the sun and the moon (<u>Psa_148:6</u>) may show that the word sometimes means less than eternity or only an apparent eternity. The word occurs with the word 'ôlām (H5769) (<u>Psa_10:16</u>; <u>Psa_45:6</u> [7]; <u>Dan_12:3</u>) and sometimes with the word neṣaḥ (H5331) (<u>Psa_9:18</u> [19]; http://myHebrewBible.com/Article/691

Amo_1:11).
