Probably of foreign origin; Amalek, a descendant of Esau; also his posterity and their country: - Amalek.

### Search for Amalek and Amalekites

- <u>Gen 14:7</u> And they returned, and came to Enmishpat, which *is* Kadesh, and smote all the country of the Amalekites, and also the Amorites, that dwelt in Hazezontamar.  $^{1}$
- <u>Gen 36:12</u> And Timna was concubine to Eliphaz Esau's son; and she bare to Eliphaz <u>Amalek</u>: these *were* the sons of Adah Esau's wife.
- <u>Gen\_36:16</u> Duke Korah, duke Gatam, *and* duke <u>Amalek</u>: these *are* the dukes *that came* of Eliphaz in the land of Edom; these *were* the sons of Adah.
- Exo\_17:8 Then came Amalek, and fought with Israel in Rephidim.
- <u>Exo\_17:9</u> And Moses said unto Joshua, Choose us out men, and go out, fight with <u>Amalek</u>: to morrow I will stand on the top of the hill with the rod of God in mine hand.
- Exo 17:10 So Joshua did as Moses had said to him, and fought with Amalek: and Moses, Aaron, and Hur went up to the top of the hill.
- Exo 17:11 And it came to pass, when Moses held up his hand, that Israel prevailed: and when he let down his hand, Amalek prevailed.
- $Exo_{17:13}$  And Joshua discomfited Amalek and his people with the edge of the sword.
- Exo 17:14 And the LORD said unto Moses, Write this *for* a memorial in a book, and rehearse *it* in the ears of Joshua: for I will utterly put out the remembrance of Amalek from under heaven.
- <u>Exo\_17:16</u> For he said, Because the LORD hath sworn *that* the LORD *will have* war with Amalek from generation to generation.
- <u>Num\_13:29</u> The Amalekites dwell in the land of the south: and the Hittites, and the Jebusites, and the Amorites, dwell in the mountains: and the Canaanites dwell by the sea, and by the coast of Jordan.
- <u>Num 14:25</u> (Now the Amalekites and the Canaanites dwelt in the valley.) To morrow turn you, and get you into the wilderness by the way of the Red sea.
- <u>Num\_14:43</u> For the Amalekites and the Canaanites *are* there before you, and ye shall fall by the sword: because ye are turned away from the LORD, therefore the LORD will not be with you.
- <u>Num 14:45</u> Then the <u>Amalek</u>ites came down, and the Canaanites which dwelt in that hill, and smote them, and discomfited them, *even* unto Hormah.
- <u>Num\_24:20</u> And when he looked on <u>Amalek</u>, he took up his parable, and said, <u>Amalek</u> was the first of the nations; but his latter end *shall be* that he perish for ever.
- <u>Deu\_25:17</u> Remember what <u>Amalek</u> did unto thee by the way, when ye were come forth out of Egypt;<sup>2</sup>

- <u>Deu 25:19</u> Therefore it shall be, when the LORD thy God hath given thee rest from all thine enemies round about, in the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee *for* an inheritance to possess it, *that* thou shalt blot out the remembrance of Amalek from under heaven; thou shalt not forget *it*.
- <u>Jdg\_3:13</u> And he gathered unto him the children of Ammon and Amalek, and went and smote Israel, and possessed the city of palm trees.
- <u>Jdg 5:14</u> Out of Ephraim *was there* a root of them against <u>Amalek</u>; after thee, Benjamin, among thy people; out of Machir came down governors, and out of Zebulun they that handle the pen of the writer.
- <u>Jdg\_6:3</u> And *so* it was, when Israel had sown, that the Midianites came up, and the <u>Amalek</u>ites, and the children of the east, even they came up against them;
- <u>Jdg\_6:33</u> Then all the Midianites and the Amalekites and the children of the east were gathered together, and went over, and pitched in the valley of Jezreel.
- <u>Jdg 7:12</u> And the Midianites and the <u>Amalek</u>ites and all the children of the east lay along in the valley like grasshoppers for multitude; and their camels *were* without number, as the sand by the sea side for multitude.
- <u>Jdg 10:12</u> The Zidonians also, and the <u>Amalek</u>ites, and the Maonites, did oppress you; and ye cried to me, and I delivered you out of their hand.
- <u>Jdg\_12:15</u> And Abdon the son of Hillel the Pirathonite died, and was buried in Pirathon in the land of Ephraim, in the mount of the Amalekites.
- <u>1Sa</u> <u>14:48</u> And he gathered an host, and smote the <u>Amalek</u>ites, and delivered Israel out of the hands of them that spoiled them.
- <u>1Sa</u> <u>15:2</u> Thus saith the LORD of hosts, I remember *that* which <u>Amalek</u> did to Israel, how he laid *wait* for him in the way, when he came up from Egypt.
- <u>1Sa\_15:3</u> Now go and smite <u>Amalek</u>, and utterly destroy all that they have, and spare them not; but slay both man and woman, infant and suckling, ox and sheep, camel and ass.
- <u>1Sa\_15:5</u> And Saul came to a city of Amalek, and laid wait in the valley.
- <u>1Sa\_15:6</u> And Saul said unto the Kenites, Go, depart, get you down from among the <u>Amalek</u>ites, lest I destroy you with them: for ye shewed kindness to all the children of Israel, when they came up out of Egypt. So the Kenites departed from among the <u>Amalek</u>ites.
- <u>1Sa\_15:7</u> And Saul smote the Amalekites from Havilah *until* thou comest to Shur, that *is* over against Egypt.
- <u>1Sa</u> <u>15:8</u> And he took Agag the king of the <u>Amalek</u>ites alive, and utterly destroyed all the people with the edge of the sword.
- <u>1Sa</u> <u>15:15</u> And Saul said, They have brought them from the Amalekites: for the people spared the best of the sheep and of the oxen, to sacrifice unto the LORD thy God; and the rest we have utterly destroyed.
- <u>1Sa</u> <u>15:18</u> And the LORD sent thee on a journey, and said, Go and utterly destroy the sinners the <u>Amalek</u>ites, and fight against them until they be consumed.
- <u>1Sa\_15:20</u> And Saul said unto Samuel, Yea, I have obeyed the voice of the LORD, and have gone the way which the LORD sent me, and have brought Agag the king of Amalek, and have utterly destroyed the Amalekites.

- <u>1Sa</u> <u>15:32</u> Then said Samuel, Bring ye hither to me Agag the king of the Amalekites. And Agag came unto him delicately. And Agag said, Surely the bitterness of death is past.
- <u>1Sa\_27:8</u> And David and his men went up, and invaded the Geshurites, and the Gezrites, and the <u>Amalek</u>ites: for those *nations were* of old the inhabitants of the land, as thou goest to Shur, even unto the land of Egypt.
- <u>1Sa</u> 28:18 Because thou obeyedst not the voice of the LORD, nor executedst his fierce wrath upon Amalek, therefore hath the LORD done this thing unto the this day.
- <u>1Sa\_30:1</u> And it came to pass, when David and his men were come to Ziklag on the third day, that the Amalekites had invaded the south, and Ziklag, and smitten Ziklag, and burned it with fire;
- <u>1Sa\_30:18</u> And David recovered all that the Amalekites had carried away: and David rescued his two wives.
- <u>2Sa\_1:1</u> Now it came to pass after the death of Saul, when David was returned from the slaughter of the Amalekites, and David had abode two days in Ziklag;
- <u>2Sa 8:12</u> Of Syria, and of Moab, and of the children of Ammon, and of the Philistines, and of Amalek, and of the spoil of Hadadezer, son of Rehob, king of Zobah.
- <u>1Ch\_1:36</u> The sons of Eliphaz; Teman, and Omar, Zephi, and Gatam, Kenaz, and Timna, and Amalek.
- $1Ch_4:43$  And they smote the rest of the Amalek ites that were escaped, and dwelt there unto this day.
- <u>1Ch\_18:11</u> Them also king David dedicated unto the LORD, with the silver and the gold that he brought from all *these* nations; from Edom, and from Moab, and from the children of Ammon, and from the Philistines, and from Amalek.
- <u>Psa\_83:7</u> Gebal, and Ammon, and Amalek; the Philistines with the inhabitants of Tyre;
