From [H5973](#) and [H410](#) with suffix pronoun inserted; *with us* (is) *God*; *Immanuel*, a name of Isaiah's son: - Immanuel.

BDB Definition:

Immanuel = “**God with us**” or “**with us is God**”

1) symbolic and prophetic name of the Messiah, the Christ, prophesying that He would be born of a virgin and would be ‘God with us’

Part of Speech: noun proper masculine

Shortened from [H352](#); *strength*; as adjective *mighty*; especially the *Almighty* (but used also of any *deity*): - God (god), X goodly, X great, idol, might (-y one), power, strong. Compare names in “-el.”

H3818 *lo ammiy* ^{KJC:1} **Loammi**^{1-Hos1:9}

From [H3808](#) and [H5971](#) with pronominal suffix, *not my people*; *lo Ammi*, the symbolical name of a son of Hosea: - Lo-ammi.

H5971 *'am* ^{KJC:1,864} **people**^{(s)1,845}, **nation**^{(s)16}, **folk**², **ammi**¹, **men**¹

עם

From [H6004](#); a *people* (as a congregated *unit*); specifically a *tribe* (as those of Israel); hence (collectively) *troops* or *attendants*; figuratively a *flock*: - folk, men, nation, people.
