From <u>H5973</u> and <u>H410</u> with suffix pronoun inserted; with us (is) God; Immanuel, a name of Isaiah's son: - Immanuel.

#### **BDB Definition:**

Immanuel = "God with us" or "with us is God"

1) symbolic and prophetic name of the Messiah, the Christ, prophesying that He would be born of a virgin and would be 'God with us'

Part of Speech: noun proper masculine Same Word by TWOT Number: 1640d

## עם

From <u>H6004</u>; a *people* (as a congregated *unit*); specifically a *tribe* (as those of Israel); hence (collectively) *troops* or *attendants*; figuratively a *flock*: - folk, men, nation, people.
