Gen 30:28 | Laban acknowledges from YHVH per Jacob and asks him for his wages

From <u>H7986</u>; *payment* of contract; concretely *salary*, *fare*, *maintenance*; by implication *compensation*, *benefit:* - hire, price, reward [-ed], wages, worth.

WordStudy

A masculine noun indicating wages, a reward, pay. It refers to monetary pay or pay consisting of material goods (<u>Gen 30:28</u>, <u>Gen 30:32-33</u>; <u>Exo 2:9</u>; <u>Num 18:31</u>). It refers to a reward given by God to Abraham for faithfulness (<u>Gen 15:1</u>). It can be rendered as hire, the amount paid to rent or hire a person or object (<u>Exo 22:15</u> [14]). It is used in the sense of ordinary expenses or the costs of maintenance or travel (<u>Jon 1:3</u>; <u>Zec 8:10</u>). The Lord's gift of children is considered a reward to His people (<u>Psa 127:3</u>). When God comes to comfort his people, His reward is with Him, just payment for what each person deserves (<u>Isa 40:10</u>).
