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#### Introduction

One of the most important differences between what makes man different from the rest of creation is language and the ability to express our selves through words. Since my passion is law, and law is formed by contract, than language becomes key because it expresses intent. The required elements of a contract must have:...

1. Offer, 2. Acceptance, 3. Consideration<sup>a</sup> 4. T's & C's<sup>b</sup>, 5. Meeting of the Minds<sup>c</sup>.

It would be impossible to have contracts if you didn't have a language.

It seems that there is two main categories for *saphah* 1) lips, edge, brim etc. and 2) language, speech and talk. On the surface, this seems a bit strange to try to make the connection for these two categories but I thought I would look at it from something that I know quite a bit about 1) law/contracts and 2) computer programming. When you're writing a coherent contract or program, you definitely want things like scope and context. To be successful you need to narrow down your thoughts and intentions as best you can to exactly identify what it is your trying to achieve. This brings focus and clarity because you can better see the edges, brims and borders.

#### **Analysis**

- H8194 saphah: Lips and Edge vs. Language, speech, talk
  - The first occurrences of H8194 is found in Gen 11 and is used 5 times in that chapter. Four times it's translated as **language** and once as **speech**.
  - o 65% of the time it's translated as lips, and most of the other times it has a sense of an edge, shore or border (lips also have a sense of a border as well).
  - The first occurrence of a word (in this case Gen 11:1-7) usually gives it dominance as to its meaning, but if you include language, speech and talk, it's less than 8% of the translations.
  - o 43% this is found in Psalms or Proverbs (Psalms 28 & Proverbs 46 totaling 74 times)
  - o H8194 is spelled with a sin, and H5595 is spelled with a samech.<sup>e</sup>
- H3956 lashon: tongue, language
  - o 84% of the times *lashon* is translated as **tongue**, and 8.6% it's **language**
  - o 47% this is found in Psalms or Proverbs (Psalms 35 & Proverbs 19 totaling 54 times)
- Search Language(s) in the Old Testament. 33 Occurrences 21% it's saphah and 52% it's lashon
